

**International School of Dakar
Public Information Summary**

Host Country:	Senegal
Name of Borrower:	The International School of Dakar.
U.S. Sponsor:	International School of Dakar, Inc.
Project Description:	Support the expansion of the International School of Dakar, a Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grade school in Dakar, Senegal.
Total Project Costs:	\$8,506,000
Proposed OPIC Loan:	\$4,500,000, for a 10-year total term, including a 12 month grace period on principal and 9-year straight-line amortization.
Developmental Effects:	The project will have a positive impact in the host country of Senegal. ISD provides American education for children of American and other diplomats, international development agency employees, members of the international business community and Senegalese students who will seek college education abroad.
Environment Effects:	Construction and operation of schools are screened as Category B projects under OPIC's environmental and social guidelines because impacts are site-specific and readily mitigated. Environmental and social issues associated with the Project include project siting, access to potable water, greenhouse gas emissions, the need for appropriate occupational health and safety measures, nuisance factors such as dust, traffic and noise during construction, wastewater treatment and disposal, solid waste disposal, and fire safety.
Worker Rights:	OPIC's statutorily required standard worker rights language will be supplemented with provisions concerning the right of association, organization and collective bargaining, minimum age, the timely payment of wages, minimum wages, hours of work, and hazardous work situations. Standard and supplemental contract language will be applied to all workers of the Project. The project company will be required to operate in a manner consistent with the requirements of the International Finance Corporation's Performance Standard 2 on Labor and Working Conditions.
Human Rights:	The Project received a Human Rights Clearance on February 7, 2011.
